Please attach an essay that is typewritten in 12-point font, double-spaced and a maximum of 500 words. **Your essay should be based on the following statement: "Since its founding, Pennsylvania has had four constitutions. The first created in 1776 by a constitutional convention presided over by Benjamin Franklin. The second in 1790 gave the Commonwealth a body of law and formed the basis for constitutions in many other states. A third in 1838 amended the previous version and the fourth in 1874 came about because of public demand to changes that took place following the Civil War. In 1967, Pennsylvania voted to hold a constitutional convention and adopted several changes to the constitution in 1968. Today, there is renewed interest in convening another limited constitutional convention. Discuss why Pennsylvania should or should not host another convention."**
