Harrisburg, PA, July 28, 2014 – The Emerging Philanthropist Program (EPP) a joint project between The Foundation for Enhancing Communities (TFEC) and Harrisburg Young Professionals (HYP), invites nonprofit organizations to apply for a new grant opportunity. Any nonprofit organization in Harrisburg and/or serving Harrisburg families with programs or services that address family development and engagement with an emphasis on those families with children ages 0-10 years may apply for a one-time grant of \$5,000.00.

Applicants must either be a registered 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, or have a registered 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization act as a fiscal sponsor for the proposed project.

Ms. Doyle will then e-mail you full application materials, including Word document templates that *must be used* for the Grant Summary Sheet, Proposal Narrative, Program Logic Model, and Budget Worksheet.
