

Scholarship Awards Are Matched By PHEAA's PATH Program

The Foundation is proud to be selected as only one of eighteen statewide participants in AES/PHEAA's "Partnerships for Access To Higher Education," or PATH Program. The PATH Program is able to match our scholarship grants on a dollar-for-dollar basis, up to twice the amount, for full-time undergraduate students who attend Pennsylvania schools of higher education. Usually, no additional paperwork is required by students in order to be eligible for a PATH Program match.

Students can benefit from the PATH Program by obtaining a scholarship from The Foundation and by meeting the PATH Program's eligibility requirements. These requirements include: 1) attend an approved Pennsylvania college or career school; 2) receive a PA State grant *and* a Federal Student Loan (\$100 minimum); and 3) demonstrate financial need. The PATH program provides last dollar support for tuition, books, and fees.
