he Perry County Community Foundation (PCCF), established in 1987, is a Regional Foundation of The Foundation for Enhancing Communities. The PCCF makes grants to nonprofit organizations that serve residents of Perry County. PCCF also serves as a vehicle for individuals, companies, foundations and charitable organizations to establish funds that will support the civic, social, educational and cultural well-being of individuals living in Perry County. The Foundation ensures that all gifts, ranging from a few dollars to a few thousand, will work to improve the quality of life for Perry County residents, today and in the future.

How Are Grants Distributed?

- · Discretionary Funds (Unrestricted and Area of Interest Funds): the Perry County Community Advisory Board accepts and reviews grant applications from nonprofit organizations and recommends funding priorities.
- Restricted Funds: income from the fund is annually awarded to the donor designated nonprofit organization.
- Donor Advised Funds: to nonprofit organizations from both endowment and nonpermanent donor advised funds.

How Do I Contribute?

You can make a donation of any amount to an existing fund or, over a period of 5 years you can establish your own named fund for as little as \$5,000..
