The Kids Trust Awards \$31,000 to Nonprofits that Provide Support to Abused or Neglected Children in South Central PA

Harrisburg, PA, April 28, 2014 – The Foundation for Enhancing Communities (TFEC) is pleased to announce The Kids Trust Fund grantees for 2013.

The Kids Trust, a fund of TFEC, was created in 2005 by and in memory of Gary L. Houck, Jr. Gary's wish before his death was to create a fund that would provide support and services to young children who are living with physical or emotional abuse, or neglect.

The annual competitive grantmaking program is for nonprofit organizations providing programs and services for children of abuse and their families in the counties of Cumberland, Dauphin, Franklin, Lancaster, Lebanon, Perry, and York.

A total of \$31,023.50 was distributed through 2014 grantmaking to the following nonprofit organizations:
