#### Attendance

This leadership program includes approximately 50 hours of session time. To complete the program, a participant is **expected to attend all sessions**. The program includes 10 evening sessions that run approximately 2.5 hours each. Additional sessions will include site visits to nonprofit organizations in the community, 2020-grantee check presentation, and other opportunities as they arise. **Attendance at each of the monthly sessions is required**. If you miss three sessions, you will not be permitted to complete the program. There will be minimal additional out-of-session time required for program completion. Participation and attendance at EPP fundraisers is encouraged. Participants are required to serve on the Planning Committee of the 2020 Harrisburg Hoopla.

#### Commitment
