To Whom it May Concern,

For the past decade, my father, Alan Adler, had derived his main source of income from a family business which amassed a huge commercial debt load, which now amounts to approximately \$262,000. My parents' 2018 tax returns show capital gains from the sale of stocks that were used to pay 2017 taxes. The majority of proceeds from the stock sale were automatically recouped by the brokerage in order to pay off the margin loan used to finance the business. The remainder was used to pay 2017 taxes. My father started a new job in February 2020 to supplement his business income. Then came COVID-19. The governor ordered the closure of all businesses, which prevented my father's company from manufacturing any product and therefore from making any sales. The company's viability is now in question. As a sole member LLC with no payroll, government assistance from the CARES act was not available at first and ran out before the business was able to receive any assistance. At the supplemental job, his salary was just cut 10% due to the economic pressures from COVID-19. The combination of these two events stemming from the pandemic has put significant additional strain on our finances this year.
