The pay is low, the hours long, it's dirty and often smelly work. The farming industry is in trouble! We have less and less young people interested in working in agricultural areas. This is where I come in and the reason I am asking for financial assistance in reaching my goal of going to college without any debt. In order to be successful in this industry, you cannot start with thousands of dollars of debt, or you will never succeed. We all continue to eat the foods farmers produce and drink the beverage their products are part of, yet so many people show no interest in preserving the industry. I have been involved with Ag for five years now and what never ceases to amaze me is that most people do not think about the farmers that produce those foods and beverages. They just go to the grocery store and never give a second thought as to what the process is to get that food to the store. I raise beef for meat. I will generally have to provide shelter, care, grain and water for a steer for up to one year before I get it butchered. After processing that meat and deducting expenses, I generally make about \$20/month. For \$20/month I am feeding a cow 2x, giving it water, cleaning stalls, throwing straw and hay, etc. This is a field you go into because you are passionate about helping others, not for the big financial rewards. I love what I do, but as I said, most Ag jobs are not high paying, so please consider awarding me the Samuel Abrams Scholarship for the second year so that I can keep my college debt low and continue to do what I love-produce food for others.
