## **Letter of Extenuating Circumstances**

Financial difficulties are one of the biggest reasons why people choose not to attend college after high school. I am a first-generation student attending college in my family. Financial difficulties were the primary reason why my family members were not able to attend college and receive higher education. I was originally born in Nepal, one of the least developed countries. My family was a refugee that migrated from Bhutan, a nearby county. I came to the United States at the age of 9 along with my family in refugee status. My parents were not able to attend college because they needed to make money to provide necessities for everyone. The income that is shown in the SAR does not accurately provide my family's current financial status as many things have changed in between. My father used to have 3 jobs which used to be our main source of income as shown in the SAR. Currently, he only has 1 full-time and 1 part-time job. He works at a warehouse company and works part-time for about 2-3 hours at Catholic Charities on business days. I have noticed that he barely sleeps for 5 hours because of work and has off days only once a week. My mom works as a cashier at Walmart full-time getting payed at minimum wage. She also has many health problems such as high blood pressure and diabetes. Recently my mom has fallen ill because of her health problems as she has diabetics and high blood pressure. She is thinking of making her job part-time or quitting the job because of her health problems and also because she does not have full-coverage insurance. The doctor's visits and medicines have been costly as her insurance does not cover most of the cost.

This year proved to be even difficult for us due to COVID-19. My mother did not work for 3 months as she falls under the vulnerable group due to her health problems. My dad also did not go to work for at least 2 months respecting the stay home order from the governor. Since both my parents do a minimum wage job in Walmart and the warehouse, they did not get paid when they stayed home. In the first stimulus check, my parents received \$2900, \$500 for my younger sister, and \$2400 for themselves. I did not receive the stimulus check as I was over 16 and my parents had claimed me as their dependent. My family is in a financial burden right now and cannot provide much assistance for me to pay for college as they have a house loan and car loans along with other monthly expenses to take care of. I have taken care of my financial expenses for college so far by working full-time over the summer and working part-time during the school year. To ease my financial expenses, instead of living on campus, I decided to attend a branch campus of Penn State close to my house. I originally had a plan of 2+2 where I would attend Penn State Harrisburg for 2 years and attend University Park for 2 more years but due to my mother's deteriorating health and financial problems, I decided to stay all 4 years at Penn State Harrisburg to save the cost for housing and food. Looking at the SAR, I won't get much financial assistance from FAFSA as they also believe that my family can afford my college expenses. But in reality, my family's income has drastically reduced over the last year. This scholarship amount I may receive will provide great relief to me and my family and help me to pay for my college expenses when FAFSA and other government aids are not available for me.

Education is one of the biggest assets an individual can hold to improve the quality of their life. With education, an individual can make better decisions and see life from a new perspective. To improve the quality of other people's lives along with mine, I am currently attending an institution known as Penn State University. I am a rising junior majoring in Biology. I chose Penn State due to its diversity, tuition rate, and the opportunities that were available for me in the beginning. I plan to further my education by attending graduate school.

The reason I chose to obtain a post-secondary education is dependent on many factors. The biggest reason is related to my passion to pursue science. I always wanted to follow a path towards science, especially medicine and research. One important incident that influenced me to pursue a career in science is when I witnessed people struggling for their life due to a lack of knowledge in the field of medicine back in the refugee camp of Nepal, the place where I was born. Healthcare was a big concern in the refugee camp as many people were not able to afford quality healthcare. As a result, many died a painful death. This event inspired me to follow a path towards medicine, specifically finding a possible cure to cancer or other life-threatening diseases through research. With education, I hope to find advances in the field of medicine that could save lives. I believe that with post-secondary education, I can make a difference in the world I am currently living and leave a positive mark or legacy as with education, my knowledge and experience will grow indefinitely.
