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### Nursing

What do you want to be when you grow up? This question was asked throughout my education at Greenwood School District. It wasn't until middle school that I began to think about the answer to this question. I told my dad that I wanted to do something where I could help people and he suggested I think about nursing. As I got older, I realized that this was the path I wanted to take.

I can't attribute my interest to pursue nursing to one experience. I watched my grandma suffer from rheumatoid arthritis and saw how the nurses impacted her in many ways during her hospitalizations. Over the summer of 2018, my mom severely broke her ankle and nurses had an integral role in her recovery. I had the privilege to babysit a Type 1 Diabetic boy over this past summer and got a glimpse of what it was like to live with diabetes at such a young age. My interest in nursing grew as my experiences did.

Over this school year, I've had the privilege of shadowing nurses throughout different hospitals. I've gotten to see, first-hand, the impact nurses have on patients in hospitals. Patients that come into the hospital are full of many different emotions. A hospital can be overwhelming and cause anxiety, stress, irritability, and other emotions for patients in addition to their original health issue. The nurses that I have shadowed made every patient feel comfortable in an environment that is not normal. It is my goal to offer that same support that I have witnessed other nurses provide throughout my life.


