This scholarship would help me tremendously to bridge the financial gap between what I have and what I will need to attend this fall. My Mother's position at her company was eliminated after 8 years due to downsizing. My Mom always had a second job that she would work 5-6 days a week in the evenings so she was able to take some extra hours but things were still very tight with the reduction in income. Now with the COVID 19 pandemic my Mom's 2nd job which had now become her primary was closed. She has used most of her savings but has been able to take advantage of the forbearances her mortgage company and auto loan company have offered so that gives a little cushion. But she is still waiting to hear from the state Unemployment office as to whether she will be able to get benefits. I know that she is worried about how she will be able to help me with tuition. I also know that she doesn't want me to take on a lot of debt and I really don't either but I really want to attend school at Point Park. My mother has told me that if she has to she will take out loans on my behalf and do her best to pay them down while I am in school. I am considering taking a lighter academic load in order to take a part-time job to help offset costs.

My Father is a great person and he remarried 9 years ago and had 3 more children. My brother and sisters are all below the age of 10 years old. He has always been and is still there to offer me support and advice but with the constraints on his budget, helping out with tuition will not be possible.

Why do I want to attend college? That is a great question. I could say that for my family there was no other option for me. Education has always been valued in my family. Both my Mom and Dad have attended college. All of my aunts and uncle have also attended and I attended an elementary and high school that placed higher education as a foregone but necessary conclusion. All of these reasons are valid. However, if I am honest with myself, the real reason I would like to attend college is so that I can really work at my craft and meet new people while doing it. My mother always tells me to "run my race". So often, I have judged myself based upon the achievements of others. If they did better than me, it somehow meant that I didn't measure up. But this year, something clicked for me and I began to understand that my journey is just as important as anyone else's and just as personal and individual. I began to run my own race. Part of running my own race is attending college to obtain my BFA in Theater Arts.

My love of acting, singing and writing has propelled me to seek attendance at Point Park University in Pittsburgh. I visited fifteen schools and applied to them all and was accepted by nine but from the moment I interacted with Point Park's faculty and visited the campus I knew that was where I wanted to go to school. I felt at home and I really like the structure of the program. I believe that I can be successful there and I believe that the faculty at Point Park want me to be successful there. When I first began this essay some weeks ago, my thoughts about what I wanted to convey were pretty clear and I have done that. But I must say that as I continue to live through COVID-19 my education has begun to mean something different. Life is delicate and what you do in this life matters. Everyone matters. I desire to do what I love to do for a living. I don't need to be wealthy or even famous. I just want to be able to pay rent, take my family to dinner and maybe take a vacation once a year. If I can do these things while being able to perform and write, my life will be worth living. It will be a life of no regrets no matter if COVID-19, 20, or 21 should interfere. I believe that attending Point Park is a foundational step for me and any assistance your foundation could offer would be most helpful.
