Personal Essay

I want to earn a Master's in Social Work to help women facing systemic oppression, struggling with reproductive issues, or facing sexual violence. Following my college graduation, I spent 5 months working for a homeless youth center, which made a big impact on the way I see the world. I worked closely with youths from the ages of 15-25 who were homeless or in foster care and needed help to become self-sufficient. Then in my Communication Studies MA program, I focused on rhetoric of women's issues. My MA helped me see the injustices that are perpetuated by our words and the realities formed by them. Upon graduating, I spent one year working for a technology consulting company, Cognizant, with which I worked with stockholders of major global corporations. While I enjoyed the challenge of problem-solving and learning a new skill, I knew that it wasn't the right career path for me. I saw sexism in my company through role placement and project assignment on a daily basis. The company made a point to promote the idea of women in STEM, but they failed to follow-through on the practice. I had already made my decision to enroll in the MSW program at Walla Walla University before I was let go due to budget cuts because I knew that I wanted to empower and advocate for women.

What I appreciate about the Walla Walla MSW program is the focus on community. Not only do they place heavy importance on the community of students in the program, but they want their students to really give back to their communities where they live. Two weeks ago, I had an information session with a few of new professors and classmates. We took turns talking about

the ways we see ourselves helping others before we transitioned to a discussion about finding practicum work. At that point, I was certain I had found the right program for my career path.
