I am writing in support of Lauren Hogan who is applying for the Roberta L. Houpt Scholarship. She was a student in my fall semester Chemical Science course at Messiah College. She will attend Cedarville University next fall as a nursing major and Bible minor.

What is unique about Lauren's placement in my course is that she is a dual-enrolled, home schooled, high school senior. Despite being a 100 level course, Chemical Science is a very demanding, fast-paced class covering general and organic chemistry along with applications to biochemistry. A prerequisite course requiring a C or better, Chemical Science is taken by all first year nursing majors who want to gain entry into the Nursing program as a sophomore at Messiah College. All first-year nursing students are required to have an overall earned GPA of 3.0 and must complete all prerequisites with an earned GPA of 2.70. These details provide you with some context to recognize the demanding circumstances encountered by first-year nursing students. Several dual-enrolled high school seniors interested in nursing had attempted to take the course in the past, but none had navigated it well enough to earn a C or better. My concern for Lauren was whether her chemistry knowledge would be sufficient to earn the course grade necessary for Cedarville's nursing program.

As I interacted with Lauren and noted her work in my course, she proved to be a very conscientious, quiet, and confident student. Her strong math skills earned her a 96% on the first mini exam in the course. She shared her exceptional problem-solving skills with other students in small group work completed during class time. As the semester progressed, her peers sought her out in small group work as she demonstrated an understanding of the difficult concepts and problem solving that were challenging to them. Lauren continued to excel in the course earning an average score of 92.6% on four exams, a 100% homework score, and a 90.5% lab score. Even more impressive, Lauren earned the highest score, 97.5%, on the cumulative final exam.

Lauren demonstrates exceptional academic acumen that will certainly enable her to navigate competently a rigorous nursing program at Cedarville University. Her maturity will be an asset as she encounters the challenges that come with transition, college life, academic expectations and independent decision-making.
