I want them to experience something that doesn't show negativity like their parents going to jail, smoking, getting high, getting drunk, a parent that only breaks promises, or a loved one that died recently but an activity that they can use to express themselves positively. It's not something I force on them, but something they come to me about.. I like to teach the kids different dances because it makes them happy, seeing them with smiles makes me feel like I'm not just another person in the world but that I have a purpose for being here. As I get older I want to pursue a career in education because the adrenaline I get when I see kids face light up, or a child coming to help me makes me feel great. It makes me feel like someone. Education is the career choice for me by helping kids; molding them to see that life isn't just negativity, and drugs but that there's greater things in this world, like college and fulfilling their dream careers just like me.
