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Dance and children are the two top things in this world that I love the most, the two things that drive me toward my career goal in education. Dance has been a passion of mine since I was 5 years old, and now that I'm 17 almost 18. As I get older I want to pursue a career in education because the adrenaline I get when I see kids face light up, or a child coming to help me makes me feel great. It makes me feel like someone. Education is the career choice for me by helping kids; molding them to see that life isn't just negativity, and drugs but that there's greater things in this world, like college and fulfilling their dream careers just like me.






