APPLICANT ORGANIZATION MISSION STATEMENT

The mission of the Jewish Federation of Greater Harrisburg (JFGH) "is to ensure that the Jewish community of Greater Harrisburg flourishes by serving as its central unifying communal organization, and by strengthening the bonds within our community and with Israel and Jews around the world." JFGH provides financial, cultural, and physical support to Jewish community organizations and their constituents throughout the Capital region. JFGH and its family of agencies serve nearly 6,000 individuals living in the greater Harrisburg area promoting the quality of Jewish life with respect for the rich diversity of Jewish values. These services include the Jewish Community Center, Brenner Family Early Learning Center, Summer Day Camp and Travel Camp, before and after-school care, athletic facility, and cultural, arts, and educational programs from infants to senior adults. All of these services are open to the Greater Harrisburg community regardless of their religious/spiritual beliefs. Everyone is welcome and many do use our services. The JCC has been in existence since 1915 and at its current location since 1958.

PROJECT SNAPSHOT

1. Capture your project and the community need it seeks to address in 200 words or less.

The JCC Day Camp is located at the Green Hills Swim Club on Fishing Creek Valley Road. While just 10 minutes from the Harrisburg JCC, the campground offers a serene, idyllic environment to spark the imagination and creative growth of campers in grades K-8. The camp boasts 27 acres of woods, a stream, Olympic and baby pools, pavilion and athletic fields and a Gaga Court. The annual summer camp program is a favorite of campers and their families and features outdoor programs, sports and games, performing arts and drama, instructional swim and recreational swim, cultural activities, arts and crafts, music, environmental living and nature and Israeli culture and Jewish life.

We are seeking grant funds to bolster our team-building and trust exercise program with the purchase of challenge and ropes course materials for our campers for the summer of 2021 as well as our aftercare students beginning in 2021. Our campers are from the ages of 5-15 years old. Our aftercare is a program we offer at the JCC after school ends from 4pm-6pm for kids ages Kindergarten-6th grade. It is for public and private school students from Dauphin county.

In addition to the team building equipment being used for camp and aftercare in 2021, we are prepared to use it during the school year to meet the needs of families during this pandemic. Should we need to offer additional programming, these supplies could be used by children at the JCC who may need academic and social support as they could potentially not be in the classrooms full time this year. In short, we will pivot to meet the needs of the community during this challenging time.

PROJECT NARRATIVE

Grant funds will be used to purchase \$1,700 dollars worth of Challenge Course Materials. We will be using these at the JCC's camp, Green Hills Swim Club and for the JCC's aftercare program. There is significant diversity in race and economic need represented in the families who participate. We provide significant scholarship support to our camp families. As a camp that blends recreation with education and growth, we would like funding for this equipment because it will allow us to facilitate team-building and trust growth among our campers in a way that is exciting and fun. Since our camp is not able to take place on our campgrounds for the summer of 2020 due to Covid-19 and we would like to make the school year and summer of 2021 better than ever as most of our campers look forward to going to camp all year. The equipment funded will be used year round and then will continue to be used for the life of the equipment.

FUNDING

We are seeking \$1,700 from TFEC. We will be unable to offer this program to our campers without the grant or outside funding.

At the end of the summer 2021 we will have the campers fill out a questionnaire explaining what their favorite camp activities are and include the Challenge Course Materials. In addition, this activity will be offered as a "choice" activity where the campers can sign up for any activity available to them. We will measure the success of the materials by how many children sign up for the Challenge Course

from week to week. For our JCC aftercare students, we will have them fill out a survey asking to rate their experience of the equipment.
