KAAN 2024 COVID-19 health and safety policy

At this time, KAAN does not require COVID vaccination or have mask requirements.

We ask that you follow best-practice guidelines for prevention and if you should experience COVID-19 symptoms.

Best practices include but are not limited to

- Stay up to date with COVID-19 vaccines and boosters
- Maintain improved ventilation throughout indoor spaces when possible
- Follow CDC recommendations for isolation and quarantine, including getting tested if you are exposed to COVID-19 or have symptoms of COVID-19
- If you are immunocompromised or at high risk for severe disease
 - Have a plan for rapid testing if needed (e.g., having home tests or access to testing)
 - Talk to your healthcare provider about whether you are a candidate for treatments like oral antivirals, PrEP, and monoclonal antibodies.
