Education gives me a choice in my life, self-dependence, and confidence in myself through the path that it will allow with the path to a job. It will also allow me to support the person I love most in the world, my brother. He will most likely never be able to hold a supporting job.

I hope to study accounting. The world of business has been growing and changing, but the minority applicants to accounting programs has been weak. The new and upcoming businesses with diverse faces need more people who can represent them in a similar nature. With the skills I learned from activities I have been a part of such as STEM Mentoring, and the Leadership Enterprise for a Diverse America (a summer program held at Princeton that focused on supporting the higher education of students under represented in higher level institutions through

support including an Aspects of Leadership college like course) I hope to be able to mentor youth in my field. I hope to study accounting at the Pennsylvania State University. This particular university has always been special to me since I was a child as I visited specialist run by Penn State Health. With my sister being a Penn Stater, as it close to home (something beneficial for my appointments) I have become familiar with the campus. The community at Penn State is so proud of their school making the school a very special place to be surrounded by, while studying at one of the top institutions for accounting (ranked 19), which will do more than well to prepare me with one of the best business programs in the nation with great networking skills from the large alumni (largest living alumni). After being accepted into the Schreyer Honors Program, I knew I could make the big campus feel personal.
