She has taken 2 AP courses and 2 honors courses, which has given her the experience for rigorous courses she will need to succeed in her future study of molecular biology. She has earned A's in all of her high school courses, with the exception of a B in one of her AP courses. Her academic balance is further demonstrated by her respectable SAT scores of 590 on the reading/writing section and 580 on the math section.

For balance in her life, she enjoys reading, painting, creative writing, and studying constellations.
