I've had chances to help at food banks like *New Hope Ministries*, and *Feed Our Starving Children*.

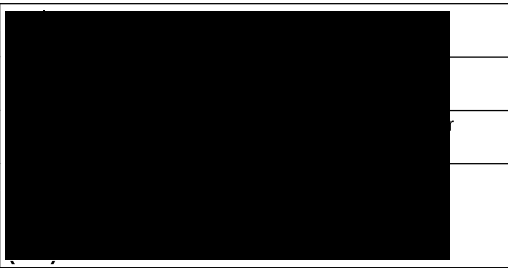
