



I think it is important to speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves. This can apply to many causes, but I am especially passionate about animal welfare. I have volunteered with Speranza Animal Rescue during the entirety of my high school career. I spend about ten hours every week walking the dogs there, which helps them get exercise and improves their socialization skills, making them more adoptable. I help out at events, too, by handling dogs and providing information to potential adopters. In addition, I created a spreadsheet that keeps track of all of the dogs available for adoption and their information, such as how old they are, whether or not they are dog and cat friendly, and if they are good with children. I found that many dogs, especially those in foster homes, were being overlooked when people would recommend dogs to potential adopters, and this spreadsheet helps prevent that by allowing volunteers to filter for certain qualities and see all the dogs that meet the criteria. Volunteering at Speranza Animal Rescue has been so rewarding, and all the time I have spent there has been repaid to me through valuable friendships and decreased stress. Seeing the transformations of dogs from the moment they arrive at the rescue to their first day in their forever homes has been incredible, and knowing that I play a part in that has filled me with so much gratitude. I have also learned a lot from the dogs there even though humans have failed most of them, they are always forgiving and have so much love to give. I plan to continue volunteering at Speranza Animal Rescue during breaks in college, and I'm excited to find new volunteer opportunities in Pittsburgh as well, which is home to hundreds of nonprofits. As I continue my education in the business field, I hope to utilize the skills I learn to help nonprofit organizations improve their day-to-day operations and better market themselves, thereby increasing their donor revenue and attracting more volunteers. Eventually, I plan to work in sports marketing, which opens up the opportunity for me to help with the volunteer initiatives of each sports team I work for as well, or even work directly for a team's associated foundation.


