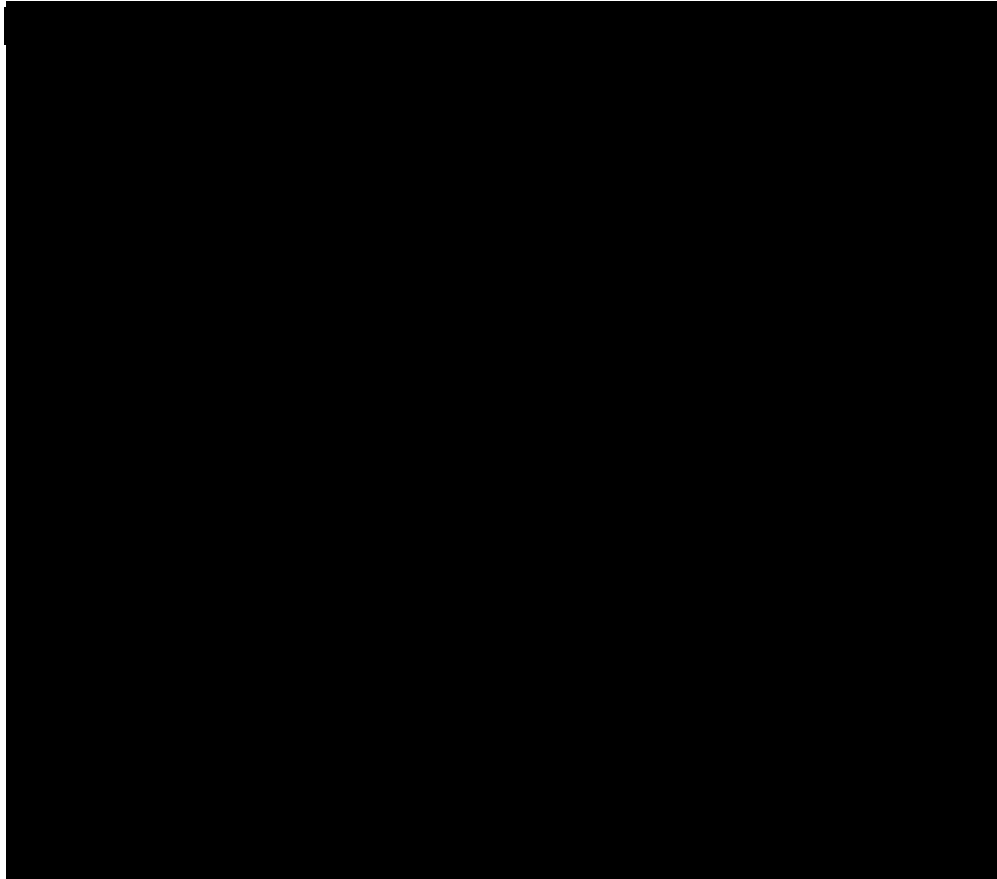

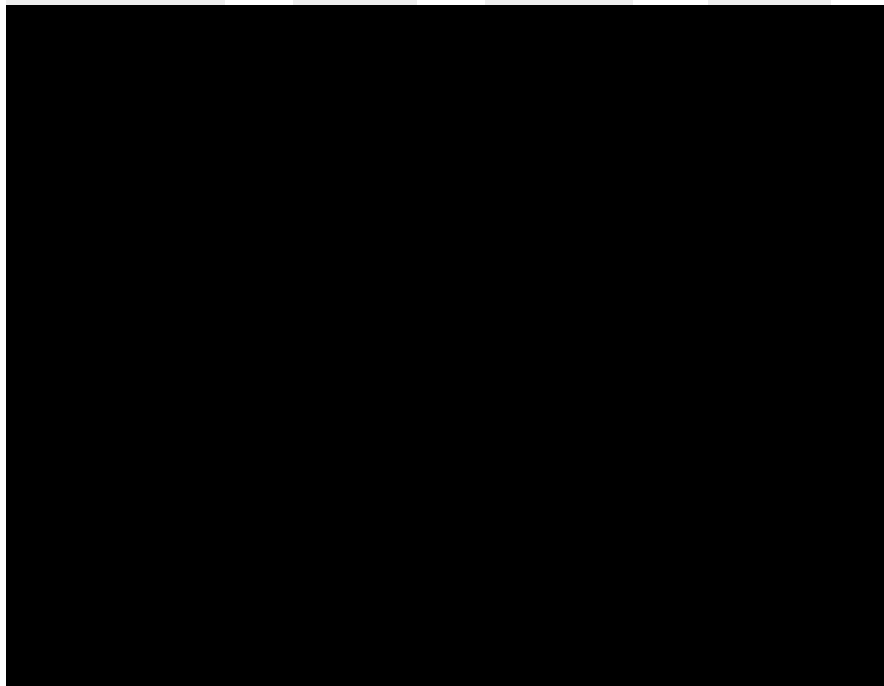



Operation Wildcat Essay

I know that I cannot do all the good that the world needs. What I do know is that the *world needs all the good that I can offer.*

Most of my community service began when I was a Girl Scout from third to sixth grade. Throughout that time, we volunteered at local churches, Operation Wildcat, ZooAmerica, the Baltimore Aquarium, the Upper Allen Fire Department, the Oaks Museum, and Mechanicsburg's Wildlife Center. From selling girl scout cookies, planting trees, raising donations and working together, I learned that community service could be just as important to the one who serves, as it is to the recipient. I'm grateful that I developed a desire to help people early on in my life, leading me to look for a common stranger in need.

During fourth grade, the girls in my troop noticed that I was a bit quirky and different from the rest of them. Eventually, I asked my mother what made me different and she explained I was diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder. I struggled to understand what that meant for me, and my entire identity fell into question. For a long time, I believed that if I couldn't help myself, I wouldn't be able to help other people. However, being in a Girl Scout troop showed me that *anybody* can help the community regardless of a diagnosis, race, or cultural makeup.

In the words of Mahatma Gandhi, "the best way to find yourself is to lose yourself in the service of others." That's why I dedicated part of my high school career to volunteering for the Special Olympics and I hope to continue to do so while attending Messiah College — home to the games in Central Pennsylvania. There's something special about being able to connect with

other people who have other developmental disorders or physical disabilities. **I have learned firsthand to embrace my extraordinary abilities and challenges. I accept that I am different. But I am not less.** People with disabilities can change the world.

Working together, I'm reminded that in helping people, I'm helping myself. Under the word of God and good will, I will continue to volunteer for the Special Olympics even after I graduate. Regardless of how I help, I strive to be the change I wish to see in the world.

All things considered, my senior year has been a time of reflection and excitement. I know that college will enhance my life — not just from the learning experience but also from the social aspect and overall personal growth. It's important for my own social development that I live on campus and push myself to spread my wings. For this reason, I have faith that Messiah College is what is best for me, regardless of the significant financial commitment. I'm honored to be considered for the Operation Wildcat Scholarship — and if selected, this scholarship will significantly help me to achieve my career goal of becoming a Forensic Psychologist.

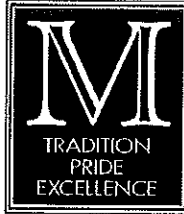
