We went through months out of school in 2012 to remain with my grandma in the medical clinic. We just returned the most recent seven day stretch of school in light of the fact that my mom was nearly losing her employment. She was the leader of our family. Our dad was missing, and we never got the opportunity to meet him. Well to make a long story short, my grandma died. She had a spinal medical procedure and never recuperated from it. She at that point experienced an enormous cardiovascular failure. We went through various months all through the clinic. We never remained in our home. My mom lost her employment since she filled in as a guardian for my grandma. Since she lost her employment, she's been battling to get a predictable line of work until this day. As I toured the school I got questioned by student ambassadors. Questions varied from "How did you find State?" and "Is Philadelphia the capital of Pennsylvania"? I laughed it off and began to question my decision on attending the university in a laughing matter. I chose South Carolina State University because I was separated from my family after 9 years. It was very hard because they were all I knew at one point in my life. I was taken away from them and choosing South Carolina State University was my way back. I aspire to become a medical doctor and they mentioned that they had a great biology program. They exceeded my expectations. My life has changed tremendously since attending the school.

For the past couple years, I've been doing research and I had my very first internship my freshman year of college at the Medical University of South Carolina. My second summer which is my current summer I am still doing research. I attend many conferences across the nation because of my department. They stated that they were very family oriented. Anything I needed during enrollment week they made sure I had. I spoke with alumni about their experiences, and shockingly many of them attended medical school upon graduation.
