I live on a dairy farm with my parents and five siblings, and due to the cost of raising six children as well as the low income of dairy farming, my parents are unable to help cover any costs of college. This means that (along with loans) I will be fully funding my college experience on my own.

More recently, due to the COVID-19 shutdown, I have had to help cover groceries and other bills because there is little to no income coming from the farm.
