Once I transitioned into high school, my mom heavily stressed how much of a priority academics were. High school is an important factor of starting your career, as it leads to college. College is an opportunity my mother could not experience. Due to her limiting abilities, she had to opt to working in order to help my grandma and her siblings. As a first-generation American, I understand the privilege I have of receiving an education. I recall during tenth grade as my mom would take me to school, she would say to me: "I came home at two in the morning last night. My arms ache, my feet hurt, my back hurts — everything hurts. When you get older, you don't have to worry about me. Go to college, get a job, and live a better life than mommy." Those remarks remained consistent as I got to my senior year. As I consider my mother's past, her statements, and my family's current living situation, I realize that obtaining a post-secondary education is for my own solace as living a better life is a priority.

At a time in your life, whether it be at a young age or middle aged, you always ponder the places you would like to live in. For me, it was Philadelphia – the City of Brotherly Love.
