Special Extenuating Circumstances

I have always enjoyed every opportunity that I had to learn. In elementary school, my classmates thought I was crazy when I said that I liked school more than a trip to Hershey Park. That statement was accurate and I truly value the opportunity to further my education. My father was an elementary school principal and had to retire on disability and is unable to work due to low blood counts and neuropathy/pain from chemotherapy and radiation. My mother works part time to supplement his disability income. Recently with the COVID-19 Crisis, my mother's work hours were slashed. She has only been working one day a week. My employment opportunity that I had lined up has been put on hold. The non-profit organization where I had interned is now under a hiring freezing until the economy recovers.

My twin sister and I both chose community college in order to be able to afford higher education and transferred to four-year universities. I chose a local university so that I could commute and still help around the house with yardwork, snow shoveling, and other chores that my father had trouble doing.

With our recently reduced family income due to my father's disability retirement, I am financing my own education. I have received student loans each semester that I will need to repay after graduation. Any scholarship assistance would be incredibly helpful. My twin sister and I lost our medical insurance coverage in 2014 so we have been forced to purchase health insurance on the federal health marketplace. My father has coverage, however, medical expenses, insurance premiums, and office co-pays and expensive prescription meds add up.

Also unfortunately my 2019-2020 FAFSA application expected family contribution is inaccurate. Tax information from 2018 included Social Security Benefits that were received retro-actively. The FAFSA Student Aid Report has been based on this tax information. I have applied for college loans and received subsidized student loans for this year and I am applying for scholarships. Student loans must be re-paid starting six months after graduation.

I am hopeful that my degree will enable me to obtain a job in my chosen field in our ever-changing work force. I have been diagnosed as having Asperger's and although I am high-functioning and receive high grades I am often overwhelmed by life changes and situations. My father's illness discouraged me at first but now I am learning that my accomplishments and achievements in college encourage him and serve to make him proud.

“The best-laid plans of mice and men often go awry” is a saying adapted from a line in “To a Mouse,” by Robert Burns. No matter how carefully a project is planned, something may still go wrong with it. I had often heard this famous line quoted and fortunately I could never relate....until this year. During my past few years in college, “my plan” was to complete my undergraduate degree, continue my communications internship, and accept a full-time position with the same non-profit organization. With rampant unemployment and economic downturns, my plan has been suspended as the non-profit was placed on a spending freeze with no new hires. In order to “make lemonade out of lemons” (yes, another quote), I have decided to pursue a Master’s degree at Penn State Harrisburg with the hope of gaining more education, becoming more marketable, and completing something during this time of unemployment.

My most meaningful achievements are reflected in opportunities where I can help others. My family always stressed being generous with my time and volunteering. I enjoyed helping others in the HACC Writing Center as a peer tutor and served as a Peer Mentor for two classes at Penn State Harrisburg. I served as a Volunteer Librarian in my neighborhood for six summers and as a Camp Counselor/Recreation Leader at a Bible camp. I now volunteer as a Children’s Bible Teacher each week and substitute in other areas as needed (assistant teacher or power point technician) at my church. I have participated in charitable walks for the Lymphoma Society. I believe that I am an excellent scholarship candidate. I was inducted into the PTK Honor Society, selected for the Pennsylvania Commission All-Pennsylvania Academic Team, earned all A’s many semesters (including my final semester), and recently graduated Cum Laude with my Bachelor’s Degree in Humanities/English. These leadership experiences showed me that I had the potential to persevere through hard times and new experiences. I have tried to apply these leadership skills in my college classes, especially on group projects, and in my various volunteer roles. With limited employment (I will have some grass-cutting gigs), student loans will be required for the pursuit of a post-graduate degree. This scholarship would lighten my financial burden. Thank you.
