Hello, my name is Tien and I recently graduated from Susquehanna Township High School in 2019. As you may know, FAFSA takes information from your family's income 2 years ago to present you with financial aid for upcoming academic years.

In 2018, my mom opened a business. It was her dream, so we all supported her and told her to go for it. At the time, we didn't have the money, so she took out loans from anyone who was able to help. She took out over \$90,000 from her 401K and had to pay an additional \$10,000 in extra fees and penalties on top of other debts. Since that money taken out was taxed, it was considered income, and therefore FAFSA believes that my estimated family contribution should sit at \$16,000. As I've already mentioned, this money went to my mom's business, so unfortunately, we currently don't have \$16,000 for my education this upcoming school year, let alone anything more than that.

This past Spring, COVID19 happened to take away lots of things for many families. For mine, it took away lots of my mom's business, both my jobs, my sister's job, and both of our semesters at college. As we know, life isn't picture perfect and sometimes people are racist.
