Our mission was to provide food, school supplies and interact with the children in the impoverishing community. It helped me to appreciate the fact that even when our family was in need, we were blessed to be able to have a warm meal at home.
I also began to cut grass for my elderly neighbors and some gave me donations for my mission trip. And as I gained experience, I was able to offer landscaping services outside our neighborhood. After returning from this trip, I had the desire to invest in my community as well. I volunteered to serve Thanksgiving dinner to the homeless and went to feed the homeless in Harlem, New York City with the Relief Bus Ministries.
Working at an early age has given me a sense of responsibility, ownership and appreciation for my personal belongings since I have been able to provide for my personal expenses.

I worked full time at Hershey Park, where I learned to handle large amounts of money, deal with customers and set up schedules. In the summer of 2018, I started to work at Weis Markets, part time as a cashier where customers knew me by name and would express their appreciation for my attentiveness to detail and by going above and beyond to assist them in their shopping experience.
