As an athlete, I remained healthy with nothing more than the normal sore muscles that one experiences with over exertion or training new muscle groups. However, it was an indoor winter training session for travel baseball when I sustained my first long-term injury with that diving catch on the turf. I had strained the muscles in my lower back and pulled the connective tissue between the ribs on my left side. This injury sidelined me for two months and led to my first exposure to physical therapy. I would later sustain another injury, a broken thumb, which would require numerous weeks of healing and physical therapy before I could return to the playing field.

Academically, I have always been strong in science and my injuries sparked an interest in learning how the body works and how it is able to heal itself. I enrolled in the Anatomy and Physiology class at school and found the content fascinating. At that point, my future became clear. My love of sports, my interest in science and the human body, and my personal experience of dealing with painful injuries led me to the decision to pursue a career in the field of physical therapy.

Physical therapy is an occupation that is projected to grow rapidly over the next ten years. The increased need for physical therapists is directly related to the increasing number of individuals who are remaining active in their later years of life. As a physical therapist, I could help others live a more enjoyable and pain-free life.
